**Are DAPs worth buying?** (feat. Pono Player)



Have you ever heard about 'Pono Player'?

Pono Player is a sort of a mp3 player that costs 400\$.

It has a rather weird prism-shape which makes the player extremely

bend-resistant, but makes it hard for people to use it in their back pockets. It has a tiny, low-resolution touchscreen with a slopy control, and a glitchy auto-tilt.

It does not have any kinds of wireless connection such as Bluetooth or AptX, so streaming music is not possible.

Battery life is rather short, only lasting 8 hours of music playback. It does not support internet connection, so you are forced to connect the player to other devices and transport music from them, or you can purchase music from Pono's own app. It was conceived by Canadian music legend Neil Young's company 'Pono'. They claim that the Pono Player will give you completely new appreciation about the music you have been listening to. Even the Canadian legend himself stated that the player will transport you to sublime musical experience. But are those statements true? Can people really differentiate between the sound quality of a regular smart phone(iphone 6s) and that of a Pono Player? To give you a better understanding their technical differences, let's take a look at what Pono Player actually does. Pono Player is called a Digital Audio Player(DAP). DAPs are advanced versions of oldfashioned mp3 players. They are meant to create an uncompressed sound of lossless music files such as FLAC, WAV, compared to most of the smart phones that just play lossy mp3 files. To do this, Pono Player utilizes its 2\$ DAC(Digital to Analog Converter), instead of using cheap sub-1\$ DACs that most smart phones are using. With these being said, the Pono Player has to sound great, right? Unfortunately, many people found it hard to differentiate between the Pono Player and normal smart phones. Famous tech reviewer Linus, from Linus Tech Tips even stated "No matter what track from what genre I have listened to, I just couldn't hear a compelling argument for why the Pono Player has any right to



exist especially in this price point, other than as a transparent attempt to build non tech savvy people for money with empty promises of an experience that it simply can't deliver."

DAPs are supposed to be better alternatives to mp3 players for anyone who enjoys high-quality music. Pono Player is just a beginner-level player that only costs 400\$. There are plenty of players that are much more expensive than this

(such as Astell&Kern AK380, which costs 3499\$, and SONY NW-WM1Z, which costs 3199\$). With this being told, do you think DAPs are worth buying? Can you really tell the differences between these and your smart phones? Are you sure to buy this players in spite of such inconveniences? Do the players give you completely different listening experiences? The choice is yours. Think wisely before you spend your money.

**How Buildings are Demolished** 

Today I'll be talking about "How buildings are demolished". Numbers of buildings in Korea almost end of their life expectancy and old buildings must be demolished for safety reasons and build new buildings. Actually, concrete buildings can last way over 60 years, but the 'doing fast' culture leads to poor construction and consequently it needs to be demolished.

The common idea of demolishing a building is blowing them up in few seconds or smashing them with a massive wrecking ball. Sounds simple and straightforward. But before blasting, there are very complicated steps.

Now I'll talk about how "Blasting demolition method" also called as "Implosion" works. The experts will calculate the amount of explosives needed and decide where to set the explosives on the structure. And then by using the detonator the experts will ignite the explosive in a very precise sequence.

The important point is that the weight of the building and the gravity make the building collapse not the explosive power. When the gunpowder





explodes in a hole drilled in the pillars, the building will lose its balance and collapse by itself.

But there is something as important as this blasting step. It is considering the surrounding environment of the building which is planned to be wrecked. If the neighboring buildings are too near the target building, the process needs to be quiet and must reduce vibration and minimize dusts. This step can be computer-simulated to ensure safety. If it is considered safe it's time for the next step.

The next step is taking off all the interior materials, such as pipes, windows, copper wirings and insulators. In this process, some materials must be removed, such as glasses which can be deadly projectiles, and insulation that can scatter over a wide area.

Then the building will be left with only its frame and now it is clear to set explosives to the columns of the building. And at this step the explosives are not placed at every floors. By calculation and simulation selected columns on floors where explosives which will be set are drilled and high explosives such as nitroglycerin, TNT, RDX or C4 are placed to the drilled hole. Finally it's ready for countdown.

This demolishing method sounds very complicated and hard. And there are some safety hazards. Any error can be disastrous, however, and some demolitions have failed, severely damaging neighboring structures. One significant danger is from flying debris, which occurs when improperly prepared, can kill onlookers.

Another dangerous scenario is the partial failure of an attempted implosion. When a building fails to collapse completely, the structure may be unstable, tilting at a dangerous angle, still filled with undetonated explosives, making it difficult for workers to approach safely.

The last danger comes from air overpressure which occurs during the implosion. I think perhaps everybody have seen at least once a window shattering by shock wave in movies. And this could happen in implosion process, too. If the sky is clear, the shock wave travels upward and disperses, but if cloud coverage is low, the shock wave can travel sideward, breaking windows or causing other damages to surrounding buildings.

But still blasting demolition is very economical and safe and fast if well prepared. And it will be an essential technique that must be studied and developed for the future use as well as for dealing with the growing numbers of obsolete buildings.

**Dunkirk Evacuation: the most impressive** evacuation in war history

The movie called Dunkirk is a recent war film written, co-produced and directed by Christopher Nolan. But did you know that this film was based on true story? Dunkirk evacuation, also known as Operation Dynamo was the evacuation of Allied soldiers from the beaches and harbour of Dunkirk, France. This historical event occurred during the World War II.

The operation was decided upon when large numbers of British, French, Belgian, and Canadian soldiers were cut off and surrounded by the German army during the Battle of France. The British commander, General Viscount Gort, concluded that his biggest mission was saving troops. Then he planned withdrawal plan from the northern part of the france and belgian coast. While, in Dunkirk, the Allied forces were trapped and they couldn't move. But all of a sudden, Hitler stopped the advance of the German army. So it was the heaven sent to the Allied Forces. And the rescue of the Allied soldiers was operated between 26 May and 4 June 1940, for 9 days. Despite the constant disturbance of Wehrmacht, the evacuation continued. On the first day of the evacuation, only 7,669 men were evacuated, but by the end of the eighth day, 338,226 soldiers had been rescued by a hastily assembled fleet of over 800 boats.

The BEF (British Expeditionary Force) lost 68,000 soldiers during the French campaign and had to abandon nearly all of their tanks, vehicles, and other equipment. But the operation was successful and saved countless lives. It brought belief that they were



survived from the war and hope to resurge. Due to Dunkirk evacuation, The World War 2 ended as the victory of the Allied forces. Until now, Dunkirk spiritual, the spirit of the British public pulling together to overcome times of adversity, is remaining in people's heart to honor the soldiers who didn't give up in the face of the despair. Many believe that this evacuation was a miracle of the war.

History of Animation from America to Japan.

The first animation was not a big issue. Of course, it did surprise people in 1900s, but animation at that time was just a successive paintings with no colour and no sound. It was when Walt Disney made 'Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs(1937)', which was both the first coloured animation and the first full-length animation. In fact, animations in early 1900s usually followed the fairy tales. It was unsurprising for animations to be considered as 'films for kids', until the Japanese animations, in other words, 'Japanimation' or 'Anime' came up.

The heyday of Japanimation began with marvelous development of science. With the great interest for new machineries and space, it was until the late 1990s that SF animations such as 'Mobile Suit Gundam(1979)', 'Neon Genesis Evangelion(1995)', and 'Ghost in the Shell(1995)' were in limelight. I, myself, think the year 1995 was the 'Miracle Year' of the animation history, because when the Evangelion(which is author's favorite animation) was being broadcasted on television, one of the most fantastic animation came out in USA. The name of the animation is 'Toy Story(1995)'.

Sponsored by Steve Jobs, the world's first 3D full-length animation 'Toy Story' brought animators to the new world. More and more animators began to create 3D animations, most of which were filmed in Dream Works and Pixar, and the result was fabulous artworks such as 'Finding Nemo(2003)', 'Frozen(2014)', and 'Inside Out(2015)'.

Though the '3D wave' covered the animation market, most of the Japanimation studios kept making 2D animations. Some legendary masterpieces came out from one of these animation studios. Its name is Studio Ghibli, famous for its major works; 'Castle in the sky(1986)', 'Spirited Away(2001)', and 'Howl's Moving Castle(2004)'. 'Spirited Away' also won academy awards, for dreamlike atmosphere and its story full of touching words.

Despite these facts, 2D animations are in

stagnation. After the 'Sailor Moon(1992)' was broadcasted, the new trend called 'Moe', which means extreme highlighting of the character showed up. People who like 'Moe anime', which are 'Love Live!(2013)', 'THE iDOLM@ STER(2011)' are called 'Otaku', usually unsociable individuals that makes other people feel uncomfortable about the animation. Though 'Your name(2016)' had a great success, it seems like it is necessary for Otaku to reduce the mass production of Moe in order to revive the animation market.

Friendship of two great novelists

When we think about a term 'friend', most of us imagine our classmates and other students we meet, talk, and play with everyday. Since we are highschool students who will become university students, love someone, and later father of a child, we often consider friends as just few of numerous people we encounter in our long life, and do not notice the fact that they have huge impact on our lives. A perfect example of this is a legendary friendship between J.R.R. Tolkien and C.S. Lewis, who are called 'the fathers of fantasy fictions'.

Tolkien was born in South Africa, where ruled by Britain at his period. He served in military and fought in World War I, where Lewis, who was born in Ireland, also took part. After the war, Tolkien and Lewis met each other for the first time in Oxford. There, Lewis founded literature club called 'Inklings' and Tolkien joined in the club, too. Since they both took part in the war and loved writing stories, they soon became friends.

By that time, Tolkien was working on a fairy tale about dwarves taking back their lost treasure from a voracious dragon. Lewis liked the story, and with his help Tolkien finally published it in 1937, with its title 'The Hobbit', and it was a great success. A few months later, Tolkien started writing another novel as sequels of his former writing, but it was far longer and more magnificent than 'The Hobbit'. Writing the fiction took about twelve years, and thanks to Lewis' praise and encouragement, an enormous trilogy of 'The Lord of the Rings' was published.

While Tolkien was working on 'The Lord of the Rings', Lewis also wrote a short story named 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe'. Once he was finished, Lewis showed his work to Tolkien, but Tolkien was rather doubtful about it. He gave sincere advice as Lewis' dear friend and bestselling author. Encouraged by friend's advice, Lewis published his

first series of masterpiece in 1950, and the great series made its end in 1956. This series of fantasy novels are titled altogether as 'The Chronicles of Narnia', which is now considered one of the two forefathers of fantasy fictions with 'The Lord of the Rings'.

Lewis and Tolkiens' great friendship continued for 37 years until Lewis died in 1963. The anecdote about two friends is now seen as the best example of lifelong friends who helped each other to succeed. Though our friends might not seem to mean that much in our long life from birth to death now, they are actually the ones who take most part in our lives like the two novelists did.

**Comfort Women**

The Red Pill: The first movie about men's rights in our world

Cassey Jaye, a feminist movie director, has produced

documentary films upon the matter of discrimination against women for eight years. However, after having found a site called, "Men's Rights Activist(MRA)" by chance, Jaye started focusing on men's rights for her films. Along the way, surprisingly, Jaye withdrew her Feminist beliefs.

"The Red Pill" offers an opportunity for us to consider men's rights issues that we have taken for

First, men's rights are in desolation. 93% of death in work sites and 80% of suicidal deaths all account for the death of men. For men, college entrance rate is plummeting, health deterioration is worsening, and vagrancy is keep increasing. Furthermore, when it comes to punishment for crime, men face approximately 63% longer jail time than women do.

Secondly, since childhood, men are socially taught to become "providers" and "guardian" for women and youth; for thousands of years, human society has disciplined male children to be utilized as disposables. In airplane crash sites, life-vests and life-boats are preferentially provided to women and children. Divorced men, but not women, maintain disadvantageous stance on custody over children. Men labor for hours on hazardous working sites to offer better lives for their wives and children. In other words, men's gradual loss of authority in households contradicts claims from women's organizations.

Third, men's life tends to be more neglected than women's. Women have always had superiority in the pretrext of value in life, and a preconception that men can be disposed at anytime or anywhere is prevalent. A few years ago, for instance, when 300 children were kidnapped in Nigeria, the media exclusively focused on the girls. Consequently, the kidnappers murdered 100 boys and sent all of the girls back home. The media did not stipulate that all of the victims were male by stating the boys' death as the death of "natives". Violence issues act the same way to men. Our society generally attributes "domestic violence" to issues of men. In reality, however, one fourth of men suffer from physical violence as much as one third of women do in the United States. Unfortunately, male victims of domestic violence are relatively not provided with enough social protection nor do they have their own stance understood in court.

Social evolution and development has brought forth the advancement of women's rights, but not for men's. Anyone must be guaranteed rights regardless of gender because any person is vulnerable to being a victim. We should all contribute to a community in which men's rights are impartially treated as women's. Films are truly fascinating in that they present every facet of possible viewpoints just like Cassey Jaye, a former feminist director, changed her perspectives on men's rights issues while she was working on the "The Red Pill".
